

SAFER TRAINED VOLUNTEERS

To be eligible for SAFER Training, volunteers must meet the following requirement:

1. Proved to be an active volunteer for three months, and
2. Completed 48 hours of volunteering with no evidence of irresponsibility.

SAFER Training is hosted once a month, typically on a Sunday afternoon at 1:30 p.m. Alyssa Ginez, HSHA's Behavior Team Leader conducts the training in her office. Training dates are regularly communicated in Volunteers Matters'. Once you become eligible and are interested in becoming trained, please send a RSVP to Megan Strausbaugh at megans@humanesocietyhbg.org.

SAFER Trained Volunteers are permitted to provide the following assistance to the shelter staff and residents:

1. Handle Animals on "HOLD" for pending adoptions.
2. Take an animal off site for enrichment or to an event.
3. Conduct Get Acquainted calls with potential adopters.
